

QUARANTINE SEEKING PERFORMER

Quarantine are seeking a final performer for our new theatre piece, Make-believe.

Make-believe will interrogate ideas about belief - starting with what it is, what it means to believe in something, how belief develops in the individual, what's going on in the brain when we believe, how difficult it is to 'suspend disbelief' in a theatre...

We have 4 performers already and we're looking for one further performer, to devise with and, potentially, to problematise the whole idea of belief.

Quarantine's approach rests on developing material from the personal history and experiences of its performers. For Make-believe, we're particularly interested in meeting someone who has strong dance and choreographic skills.

Make-believe will be directed by Richard Gregory of Quarantine, working with writer Sonia Hughes and designer Simon Banham, with input from philosopher Dr Michael Brady.

This is a full-time commitment, paid at ITC/Equity rates. You must be available for the whole of the development, rehearsal and touring dates.

You must be available for:

- 27 July to 7 August (R&D in Manchester)
- 21st September to 20 December (6 weeks rehearsal/opening in Manchester, 1 further week's performance in Manchester and 5-6 weeks' UK touring)
- and for 3 blocks of R&D of 2 days each in Manchester between auditions and mid-July to be arranged around performers' availability.

As this position involves working with a child, successful applicants will be subject to a CRB check.

- send a brief statement (max 500 words) about why you'd like to work with Quarantine

- tell us 10 things that you believe

- send a short cv/description of previous performance work
